Academic Support and Behavior Intervention Counselor

As a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic, Winnacunnet High School needs to plan for students returning to school as well as helping this transition with mental illness in mind. Oftentimes students with issues of mental health show these issues in the form of misconduct. To address these issues, we are investigating a multi-tiered approach to respond to student misconduct and are proposing an Academic Support and Behavior Intervention Counselor to provide alternative educational services and access to assignments when suspended whether in-school or out-of-school. The Academic Support and Behavior Intervention Counselor would provide behavioral intervention assistance at correcting and teaching positive behavior along with academic assistance to students who have been suspended while allowing them to stay in our building and work with our staff.

Additionally, the Academic Support and Behavior Intervention Counselor would oversee a structured study area for students who could use some guidance/executive functioning/ organizational skills during the day versus being placed in a regular study. This position further strengthens the tier 2 support available at Winnacunnet, while helping to offset the loss of Title I support. By further strengthening and varying the tier 2 support available administration expects a decrease in daily behavior incidents that escalate to out of school suspension.

Based on the success of this model, in the future, teachers could be assigned an academic support duty and/or students could be scheduled to assist as tutors.
