Reading

- Introduce high frequency words: have, like, my, look, me
- Review: I, am, the, a, see & can
- Phonemic Awareness/Phonics: Ee, Rr, Pp, Jj, Ll, Hh; syllables; rhyming; beginning/ending sounds
- Listening Comprehension: realism & fantasy; review: character, setting, sequence/plot, compare/contrast



Math

- Daily Routines: Calendar, weather, etc.
- Count forward from 0-30
- Count back from 10-1
- Read and write the numbers 1-10
- One more and one less
- Counting on from a given number
- Counting objects with 1:1 correspondence
- Analyze and name 2D & 3D shapes



Writing

- Daily writing: introducing a topic, drawing a picture, and labeling with words, phrases, and sentences. We are focusing on the most obvious sounds in a word. Correct spelling of basic words will develop over time.
